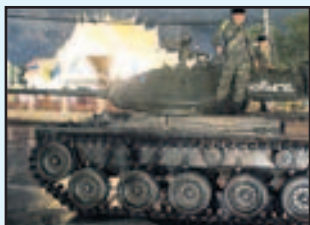

20,000

MORE than 20,000 Britons were living in fear last night after a surprise military coup in Thailand.

As tanks rolled into Bangkok and martial law was declared, ex-pats and tourists were warned to stay indoors under a curfew.

Londoner Prit Bessoa, who runs a spa products business in the capital, said: "We're in shock and very worried."

Mirror IT worker Dincel Hassan, who is in Bangkok, added: "You can see fear on everyone's faces."
